As you've already been doing crucial work on this issue, you know that the sewage crisis has made it clear that our water system is broken. Decades of privatisation have put profits before people, leaving us with polluted rivers, unaffordable bills, and failing infrastructure.

82% of the British public wants water in public hands, and 90% of the world's water is already public. This is why we've launched <u>Our Water</u>, <u>Our Way</u>, a national civil society campaign to bring public ownership back on the table as a solution.
