This document has been provided by NEYEDC to inform you of the species, sites, and habitats within your parish as recorded in the NEYEDC database. The information in this report, particularly with regards to species records, is neither static nor exhaustive, and records may exist outside of those that are stored in the NEYEDC database.

Local Sites

NEYEDC holds information on local sites systems including North Yorkshire SINCs (Sites of Importance for Nature Conservation), East Yorkshire Local Wildlife Sites (LWS), York SINCs, Hull Sites for Nature Conservation Importance (SNCI), Yorkshire Wildlife Trust Reserves and Local Nature Reserves.

Local wildlife sites (SINCs, LWS, and SNCI) are non-statutory sites designated based on ecological interest and importance for conservation. The guidelines for the selection of these sites are based on habitat (botanical) and species characteristics, identified through formal survey. Decisions are made through a panel process involving the relevant local authority, Natural England, NEYEDC, independent ecologists, and other stakeholders.

North Yorkshire SINCs have the status of Designated SINC, Candidate SINC, or Deleted SINC. Deleted SINC information is still shared as whilst they have been surveyed and assessed against the SINC selection guidelines and found not to qualify under SINC criteria, this does not mean they have no value for wildlife and could be improved with management.

The boundaries and status of Local Wildlife Sites are subject to change as sites are re-surveyed or monitored. The sites provided in this report are correct at the time of report creation. Many Local Wildlife Sites are not publicly accessible and should not be visited unless permission has been granted from the landowner or the site is known to be publicly accessible.

Legally protected and priority species

In the above table, entries highlighted in purple represent species which are legally protected species, priority species, or INNS (Invasive Non-native Species).

The designations of 'legally protected' and 'priority' are created from species lists relating to multiple different pieces of legislation. Legally protected species are those listed in certain schedules of the Wildlife and Countryside Act (1981), RSPB/BTO Birds of Conservation Concern lists, and the Protection of Badgers Act (1992). Priority species include those that fall under legislation including UK BAP (Biodiversity Action Plan species), global and european species and habitats directives, Red Data Book listings, CITES Annexes (Convention on International Trade in Endangered Species) and Section 41 of the Natural Environment and Rural Communities Act (2006).

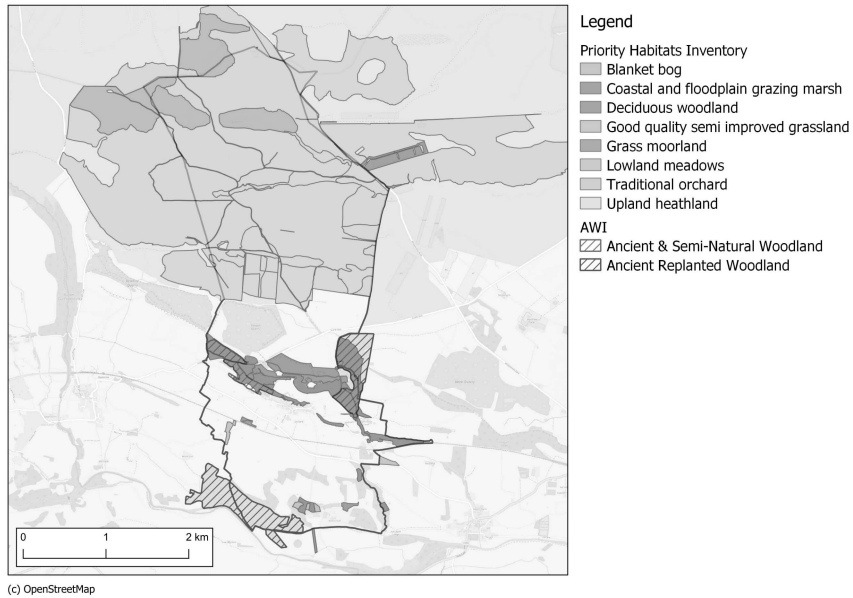

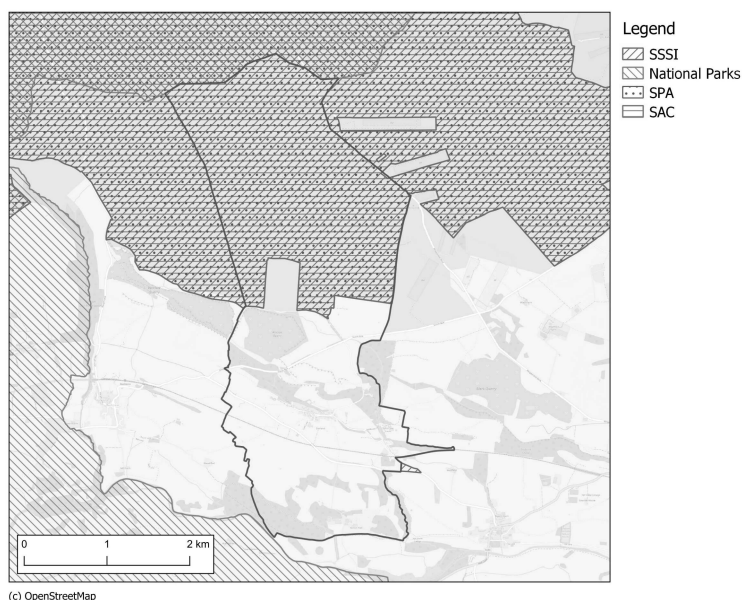

Buglife B-lines

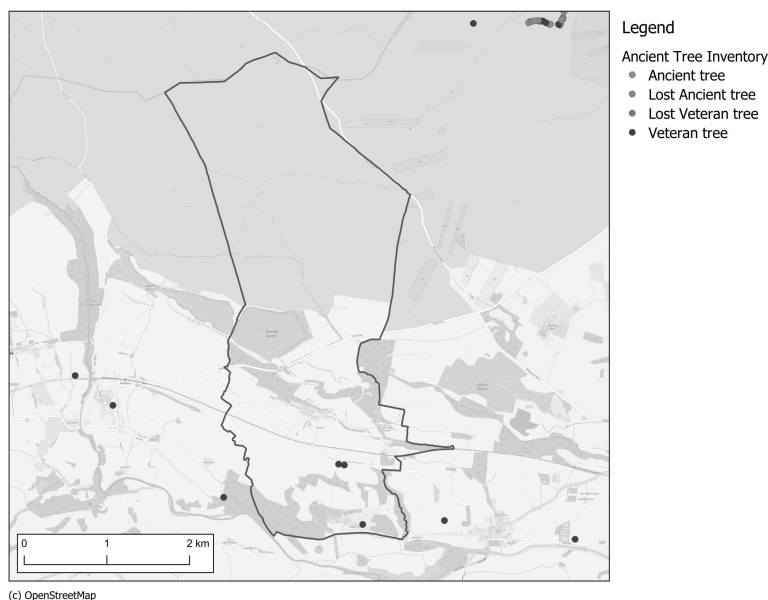
B-lines, an initiative by the charity Buglife, are a series of 'insect pathways' running through our countryside and towns, along which we are restoring and creating a series of wildflower-rich habitat stepping stones. They link existing wildlife areas together, creating a network that will weave across the UK landscape and provide areas of brand new habitat.

There are no B-lines within the parish boundary.

Ancient Tree Inventory

The Ancient Tree Inventory is a Woodland Trust project that seeks to map the oldest and most important trees in the UK. Ancient trees are those that are in the third or final stage of their life. Some of these individual trees can be aged over 1,000 years. Veteran trees have some of the features of ancient trees, but without the great age of those that fit into the 'ancient' category. All ancient trees are veteran, but not all veteran trees are ancient.

The following trees on the Ancient Tree Inventory are found within your parish.



General advice

The following ideas could be enacted at a parish level to protect and enhance biodiversity.

1. Create a biodiversity or environmental policy - These documents can be created to outline aims for how the parish can reduce impacts on the environment widely (e.g. reducing emissions, reducing light pollution, tree planting) or how the parish would protected, record, and enhance biodiversity in the parish.
2. Sharing of parish maps and species lists - The maps and species list used in this document can be shared with parish residents as a way to inform and engage them with the features of the parish and the biodiversity already recorded there. Mapping can also be a good way to identify potential habitat corridors or networks where green spaces link up.
3. Organise further survey - Targeted survey at a particular site, or for an indicator species or species group (e.g insects), can be a valuable way to understand more about key sites, habitats, and species within the parish whilst making best use of limited resources. This could come in the form of a bioblitz event.
4. Influence the management of public open spaces or parish-owned land - Land that the parish has influence or ownership under can be improved for biodiversity. This could include the installation of equipment such as bird or bat boxes or insect hotels, native species planting, creation of a wildlife pond, the development of a site management plan, enactment of a more wildlife-friendly grass cutting regime etc. This should be completed with an awareness as to whether any actions will damage or destroy an already valuable habitat, which can be identified through prior survey (see 3).
5. Record wildlife - Recording wildlife more generally is an important way to track change and monitor biodiversity. It is also an excellent way to engage parish residents and inspire interest in their local patch. NEYEDC can provide guidance and resources on biological recording. You could also make contact with

6. Engaging with gardeners, allotment holders and landowners - Encourage gardening for wildlife in private gardens and allotments with signposting to advice and resources on wildlife-friendly practices. Building good relationships with key landowners can help influence practices such as hedgerow cutting, field edge management, and other initiatives to help biodiversity.
